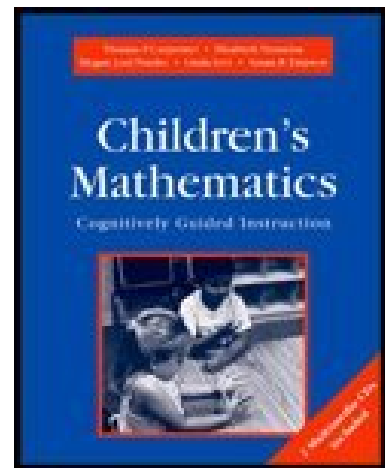
Mini-Conference: Cognitively Guided Instruction

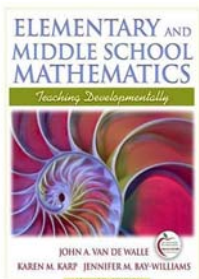
