

# GOOD VIBRATIONS

Please read the following information carefully, fill in the requested information including signature of lead adult-in-charge, and **fax to CMASE (479-575-5680)**. Registration is not considered complete until the signed form is returned.

1. Groups of 10 or more (total) attendees must register with Lynne Hehr [lhehr@uark.edu](mailto:lhehr@uark.edu) .
2. An absolute maximum of 50 **people** (students and chaperones) may attend the exhibition during any one hour period.
3. The exhibition is free-of-charge.
4. **Good Vibrations** is a stand alone exhibition that will take approximately 45 minutes to one hour to tour. This time frame will depend on the group's grade level, student interest, and number of students participating.
5. An exhibition assistant is present to answer 'how to' questions regarding the exhibits, but is not to be viewed as an education provider or a chaperone.
6. There is no special pre- or post-educational program associated with the exhibit; however, this exhibition does correlate with the Beakman presentation at the WAC on May 7-9<sup>th</sup>, 2008. For information on cost of tickets to the Beakman shows, contact the Walton Arts Center.
7. Any type of vandalism by group participants toward the exhibits and exhibition materials will not be tolerated. If any of the group behaves inappropriately toward the exhibition, exhibit materials, or personnel, the entire group **will be instructed to leave immediately**.
8. The suggested ratio of chaperones to student attendees is 1 adult per 6-8 students. This will depend on grade and/or developmental levels of the student attendees.
9. A scavenger hunt student datasheet will be provided to teachers who may want to make copies for students to use while touring the exhibition.
10. It is the responsibility of the group's adults-in-charge to maintain discipline among those attending.
11. The *Arkansas Discovery Network*, *University of Arkansas*, *Center for Math and Science Education*, and *Walton Arts Center* are not responsible for inappropriate misuse of exhibition materials that results in injury.
12. Food and/or beverages are not allowed in the exhibition.
13. Parking for the Walton Arts Center (located at the corner of Dickson Street and West Avenue) is to the west of WAC on West Avenue.
14. *Kids' Quest* members should bring their passport.
