- **All Junior and Senior Division 1st and 2nd place winners will be asked to give an oral presentation** at NWARSEF between 12:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. on March 12, 2010. All Senior Division students must give a presentation on March 12th in order to be eligible for state competition. Junior Division entries do not go on to state competition.
- Teachers will be needed as moderators for these sessions. If you are willing to help, please let us know before the first week of March. More information will be sent to you later.
- All AJAS winners will be recognized during the NWA Regional Science and Engineering Fair Awards Ceremony between 4:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. on March 12, 2010.
