This professional development opportunity requires a two-year commitment in order to foster systemic change in mathematics instruction.

Initial training will begin in the summer of 2009 with training continuing through the spring of 2011. Requests to participate in **MathLINKS** (Learning, **IN**struction, **KN**owledge, and **ST**andards) for Grades 7-8 will be reviewed and classes formed based on the following criteria:
