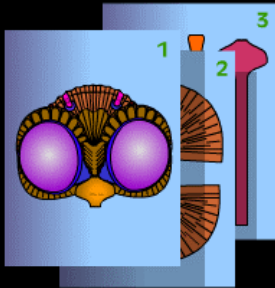


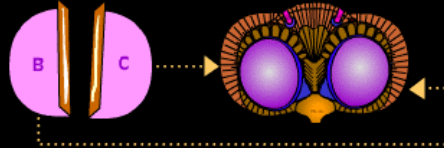
## Step 1

Print out the pages. If you have a color printer, print out the color version. If you have a black and white printer, print out the blank version and color it in however you like.



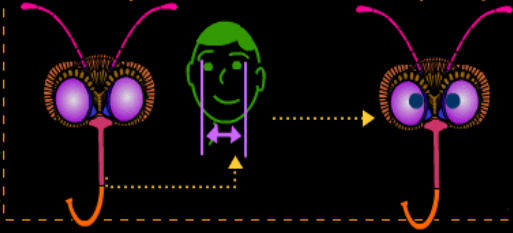
## Assembly

2. Apply glue to the folded area on piece B. Glue it to the left side of the back of piece A, positioning it so the word "top" is at the top. Do the same for piece C, gluing it to the right side of the back of piece A.



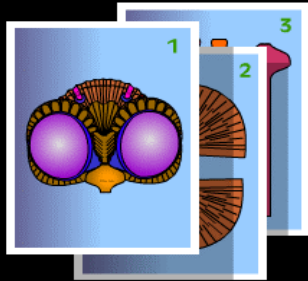
## Assembly

8. Place the mask against your face to determine your eye position.  
- Remove the mask from your face and use a scissors to poke a small hole for each of your eyes.



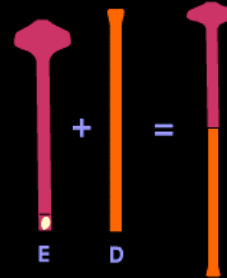
## Step 2

Glue or paste each sheet to a piece of construction paper.



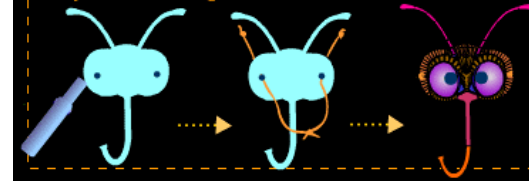
## Assembly

3. - Apply glue to piece E on the area marked "Glue here."  
- Glue the rectangular end of piece D to piece E so that the two pieces form one long strip. Allow glue to dry.



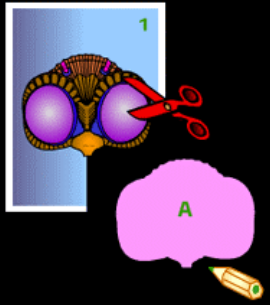
## Assembly

9. Use a hole punch to make a hole in pieces B and C.  
- Run a piece of string through each hole and tie it to fasten.  
- Tie the two ends behind your head to wear the mask.  
- Adjust the string for a comfortable fit.



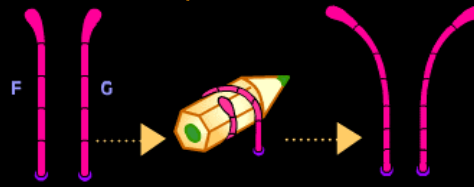
## Step 3

Cut out each piece along the solid outlines. Write the piece's letter on its back.



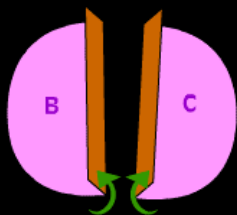
## Assembly

4. While glue is drying, curl piece F by wrapping it around a pen, pencil, or marker. Wrap it colored side DOWN so it curls forward.  
- Do the same for piece G.



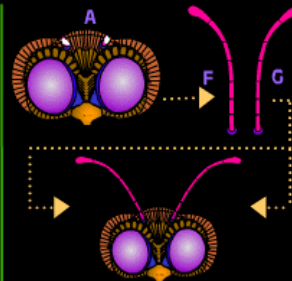
## Assembly

1. Fold pieces B and C back at the dotted lines.

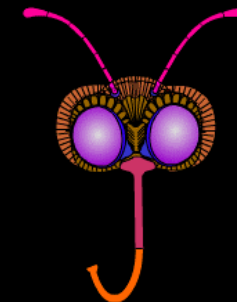


## Assembly

5. - Apply glue to the two spaces marked "Glue here" at the top of piece A.  
- Glue the round end of piece G to the spot on the right. Glue the round end of piece F to the spot on the left.
